**Message: Project Update**

The purpose of this notice is to provide you with a summary of the recent activities on the Wood Building Products NESHAP project. While many tasks were required to complete each of the activities listed below, we are providing only a general overview of the status of the project development.

- Responses to the Information Collection Requests were received and for each of these responses, we performed various quality control checks and entered the information into a database.
- We then generated a number of reports from the database to summarize information on such topics as major/minor status of the facilities; coating usage and HAP content of coatings; solids content; HAP content and cleaning materials, and adhesives; and whether facilities might be considered small businesses.
- From these reports we were able to calculate an estimate of emissions for the facilities.

- We have developed an approach for determining the MACT floor level of control and have calculated preliminary MACT floors. Our next efforts will be focused on estimating impacts of the standard based on the preliminary MACT floor level of control.
- We plan to hold the next roundtable meeting on Tuesday July 27, 1999.
