(New York, NY – July 27, 2017) On August 9, 2017, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency will hold a public meeting at John Jay College in Midtown Manhattan to discuss the EPA's second review of the cleanup of PCB-contaminated sediment in the upper Hudson River.
