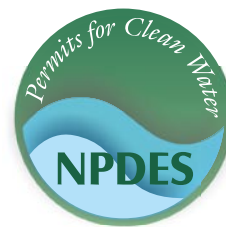

Session Description: Phase I and Phase II municipal stormwater programs are required, through reporting, to assess the effectiveness of their activities in meeting permit requirements and water quality goals. Municipal stormwater programs have typically accomplished this through limited water quality monitoring and general, qualitative assessments of their activities. A new guidance from the California Stormwater Quality Association has been developed to assist municipal stormwater program managers in more objectively assessing effectiveness. This webcast will present the Municipal Stormwater Program Effectiveness Assessment Guidance, which describes a range of assessment methods that municipalities can use to assess all aspects of their program. The webcast will also describe EPA expectations for where Phase II stormwater programs should be after five years of implementation.
