EPA is offering a webcast to describe Agency efforts to develop a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) general permit for discharges from the application of pesticides in those few areas nationwide where EPA is the NPDES permitting authority. EPA public noticed its draft Pesticides General Permit (PGP) in the Federal Register on June 4, 2010. This webcast is intended to provide an overview of the Agency's draft PGP and to answer questions related to the PGP to help stakeholders better formulate comments on the permit. Those comments are due back to EPA within 45 days of publication, or by July 19, 2010. This webcast will cover:

- ▶ Current Legal Status of NPDES Requirements for Discharges from the Application of Pesticides
- ▶ Draft PGP conditions related to:
 - Scope of General Permit
 - Notice of Intent (NOI) for Obtaining Permit Coverage
 - Effluent Limitations
 - Pesticide Discharge Management Planning
 - Corrective Action
 - Monitoring, Reporting, and Recordkeeping Requirements
