Post-Construction is, perhaps, the most challenging minimum measure that Phase II communities must implement. This webcast will introduce concepts that are being developed for a new post-construction guide that is being developed by the Center for Watershed Protection and Tetra Tech for EPA. This post-construction guide includes several valuable tools, such as a post-construction program self-audit, model ordinance, checklists, and a design manual builder with information on the best state and local stormwater manuals across the country. The guide also includes practical steps for integrating large-scale planning concepts, such as Smart Growth, and site-level practices, such as low impact development, to help make post-construction stormwater programs effective.
