

## Stormwater Webcast

### Stormwater Questionnaires for Regulated and Non-regulated MS4s

**Session Description:** EPA is currently developing a proposed rulemaking to strengthen its stormwater program under the Clean Water Act with particular emphasis on reducing the impact of stormwater discharges from new and redeveloped sites to our Nation's waters (See Federal Register Notice (74 FR 68617, December 28, 2009)).

To inform this proposal, EPA is distributing questionnaires to various entities that may be affected by any regulation. In particular, in mid-August, EPA sent two separate questionnaires to a sample of the Phase I and Phase II regulated MS4s (i.e., "Regulated MS4 Questionnaire") and a sample of localities that are not currently subject to federal stormwater requirements (i.e., "Non-regulated MS4 Questionnaire"). Recipients have 60 days to complete and return the questionnaires. The purpose of this webcast is to briefly describe the purpose of the questionnaire, how the questionnaire data will be used, how recipients were selected, and to answer questions about the type of information that needs to be submitted. People who did not receive a questionnaire may attend the webcast, but EPA will only be answering questions about the questionnaires during this webcast. In early to mid September, EPA is distributing a second set of questionnaires to a sample of owners or operators of point source discharges that are involved with new construction, development and redevelopment of residential, non-residential, industrial, and commercial properties and transportation projects. EPA will hold another webcast on October 14 for those who received the owner/developer questionnaires.
