**Description:** The Florida Department of Environmental Protection and EPA Region 4 are hosting a 2-hour webinar on April 27 entitled “Stormwater and TMDLs: Making the Connection – An Introductory Workshop for Phase II MS4 Permittees in Florida.”

The webinar will provide introductory and basic orientation information on water quality standards, stormwater permits, and TMDLs, and focus on how water quality impairments can be addressed through local stormwater management programs. Examples of program activities in Florida communities will be highlighted.

Because the NPDES permitting program seeks to reduce pollutant discharges to surface waters listed as impaired, public entities with regulated separate storm sewer systems have a vital stake in understanding TMDLs and their role in improving water quality. This workshop is intended to provide that basic understanding, for small and medium-sized MS4 permittees in Florida. Note that this workshop is not intended for large MS4s, or those seeking information on advanced topics, such as pollutant loading model selection, BMP load reduction performance, or other advanced topics.
