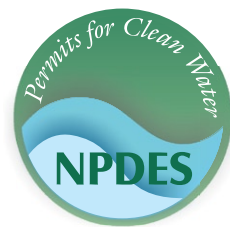

Monitoring and Reporting for EPA's 2008 MSGP

Session Description: On September 29, 2008, EPA released its new multi-sector general permit (MSGP) regulating the discharge of stormwater from 29 different industrial sectors. Most facilities were required to apply for permit coverage by January 5, 2009, and certain sectors are required to begin monitoring stormwater discharges starting April 1, 2009. This webcast will discuss the monitoring requirements in the 2008 MSGP, including how to collect samples, complete an MSGP Discharge Monitoring Report (MDMR) form, and submit the monitoring results electronically via EPA's eNOI system. In addition, the webcast will also discuss annual and other reporting requirements for all facilities. This webcast follows up on EPA's November 5, 2008, webcast on "EPA's New Industrial Stormwater Permit: What You Need to Know About the 2008 MSGP," which focused on application and SWPPP requirements in the 2008 MSGP.
