CONCLUSIONS:

The Cancer Peer Review for Lindane currently scheduled for February will have to be delayed. The data package required to present Lindane to the cancer Peer Review Committee is incomplete (see discussion).

DISCUSSION:

Upon completion of the Data Evaluation Report of the chronic/ oncogenicity rat feeding study on Lindane, it was determined that additional data is required. This study has been classified as core-supplementary due to incomplete histologic examination of adrenals. The company will be requested to section and examine all adrenals from the low and mid dose animals since there is almost a doubling of pheochromocytomas between controls and the high dose The company is also being requested to submit historical control data for this tumor type for Wistar rats. This issue has been discussed with Dr. Brenneke (phone 12/22/92) and he is in agreement that the remainder of the adrenals need to be sectioned since the of concern is frequently only microscopically.

It should be noted that Lindane has been put "below the line" of priority items for Special Review.
