Request for Extension - Field Residues - Arizona - Green Onions and Spinach

On September 2, 1988 Pennwalt Corporation was notified by Orius Associates, Incorporated that Federal Express lost the green onion and spinach samples from our mane b field residue trials in Arizona. Once the samples were finally tracked down, they were partially decomposed and totally useless. These samples were due to be analyzed and reported to EPA by October 1, 1988.

The remaining two green onion trials and the one spinach trial were completed on schedule and will be submitted by the October 1, 1988 deadline. This information is in addition to the green onion studies submitted in March of 1988, MRID 40540113, and the spinach study, MRID 40540111.

Pennwalt has made plans to reschedule the Arizona trials. Planting is scheduled for early October, and final harvest should be completed by January 31, 1989. Analysis and final report write up should be completed by the end of March. Pennwalt requests an extension of the due date until March 31, 1988 for the Arizona trials.
