INTRODUCTION

The petitioner is now proposing the following tolerances:

- 75 parts per million in or on rice straw.
- parts per million in or on rice bran, rice polishings and other rice bran milling fractions.
 - 6 parts per million in or on rice hulls.
 - 2 parts per million in or on rough rice.
- 0.10 part per million negligible residue in meat, fat, and meat by-products of beef and dairy cattle, goats, hogs, horses, sheep and poultry.
- 0.05 part per million in eggs and milk.

The proposed tolerance 05.05 parts per million in meat was changed and 75 parts per million in rice straw was added at FDA's request of September 4, 1970.

The residue data in this petition appears sufficient to support the proposed revisions in tolerances.
