On October 6, 1970, the petitioner submitted revised Section F.

A favorable opinion is given for the proposed tolerances of 75.0 parts per million in or on rice straw; 10.0 parts per million in or on rice bran, rice polishings and other rice bran milling fractions; 6.0 parts per million in or on rice hulls; 2.0 parts per million in or on rough rice; 0.10 part per million negligible residue in meat, fat, and meat by-products of beef and dairy cattle, goats, hogs, horses, sheep and poultry; and 0.05 part per million in eggs and milk.

The revised opinion is favorable for the proposed tolerances.
