Address company response to Toxicology Branch review of 78 week dietary study of Dimethoate in the mouse.

### Response:

American Cyamamid has submitted a response rebutting Toxicology Branch's review of the mouse oncogenicity study of Dimethoate (Accession Number 265362-265364) which concluded that dimethoate was oncogenic in male and female B6C3Fl mice.

This rebuttal, along with all other relevant information will be presented to the Toxicology Branch Peer Review Committee for consideration in determining the oncogenic potential of the compound.
