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#### Comments

Trifluralin is not likely to reach to gw; it is immobile, with a Kd of around 80, and oct./water coefficient of 118,000. Trifluralin residues detected in soil aterR 73 weeks ranged from 10.9 to 19.6% of applied radioactivity. LC50 for rainbow trout = 12-40 ppb (highly toxic)
