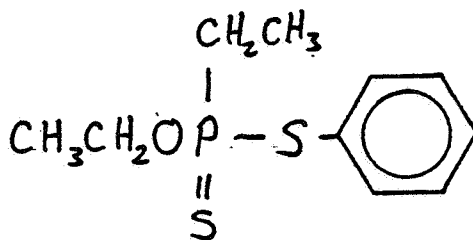

The PM wishes EFB to consider Stauffer's request to permit rotating onions treated with Dyfonate to carrots. The registrant claims residue data supports removal of the restriction.

- 2.1 We do not concur with the removal of the rotational restriction to permit planting of carrots after Dyfonate treated onions. To consider removal of the restriction, we will have to review the residue data mentioned on the first page of Stauffer's September 29, 1980 letter.

The following amendments to the DYFONATE 10-G label are being proposed at this time, and for ease of review are highlighted in yellow on the enclosed draft label:

CARROTS

- . Modification to rotational restriction to permit rotation of carrots with onions treated the previous year at time of planting with furrow application of DYFONATE 10-G. Residue data from carrots rotated the following year after treatment with DYFONATE, indicated no potential residue problems from rates as high as 1.0 lbs. a.i./A. The onion use is the only pre- or at-planting time application on these labels which is treated at 1.0 lbs. a.i./A or less.
