Dosage for filberts is 1 to 3 pts/A (0.25 to 0.75 lb.A/A) repeat as necessary. Do not graze treated groves for 21 days after last application. Pecans & walnuts also have the 21 day grazing caution.

Soybean oil proposed tolerance appears on Food Additive Petition No. 8E2201.

Cowpeas have been changed to blackeyed peas (southern peas, crowder peas).

Subject: Pasticide Petition Number 770539 requesting telerances for 0,0dimethyl 5-[4-auo-1,2,3-benzotrianin-9(41)-ylanthyl] phosphorodithicate (Suthica) submitted by Chewagre Corporation, and filed October 5. 1966.

Please refer to our nemotandes of Boyanber 1, 1966.

On December 3, 1967, the patitioner submitted revised Sections B and Y. Section 5 has been amended as fellows:

- 1. The pre-hervost interval for soybeens has been changed to 45 days.
- 1. Compens has been changed to blackeyed peas (southern peas and crowder seas).
- 3. The use of Suthios on filberts has been edded.

Section F has been seended as follows:

- 1. The proposed use and toleraness for Guthlon in or on calons (green and dry), wheat and eats has been deleted.
- 2. The new proposed telegeness for Guthion ers 0.1 part per million (pps) in or on beams, blackeyed peas (nonthern pens, crowder pess), eggplant, filberts, pecase, walnuts, potetues and pappers; and 0.2 year in or on saybeans.

As required by Public Law 518, 83rd Congress, we herein offer an epinion as to whether the proposed tolerances reasonably raffect the amounts of residues likely to result when this perticide elemical is used as proposed.

It is the opinion of this Department that the proposed telerances reasonably reflect the excepts of residues likely to result.

It is noted that Section F requests a tolerance for Guthion of 1.0 ppm in soybean oil. No opinion is given since Food Additive Petition No. 8H2201 includes this proposal.
