Attached are EAB TASKS I, II, and the data table for the subject Registration Standard.

This is to inform you that the attached Registration Standard does not contain an Exposure Assessment. It is our understanding from the Special Review Section (Curt Lunchick, EAB) that the data for this assessment is enroute from Canada and will be forwarded to RD when it is completed.

Also, Dynamac was uncertain (in their TASK II write-up) whether there was a true forest use for azinphosmethyl, or only treatment of plantation type stands of slash pine trees. A review of the labels indicated that 12 labels from 8 manufacturers show a forest use. We have indicated on the data tables and in Task II that the forest use data may be waived if this use is removed from the label, or if the use is defined as referring to tree plantations that are not true forest environments.
