The registrant has complied with most of the efficacy product labeling revisions outlined in the Agency letter dated July 22, 1991. However, listed below are Agency recommended labeling changes:

The registrant has not submitted data to verify the claim for sanitization of air ducts. Furthermore, due to the current controversy and proposed PR Notice on claims for Air duct sanitization/disinfection, the request to retain the claim is denied. Therefore, Sporicidin Bulletin No. 302 is unacceptable.

Registrant must submit Sporicidin Bulletin 301 for Agency review.

Under the heading "TO DISINFECT AND DEODORIZE" expand the wording to comply with those elements outlined in DIS/TSS-15 attached.
