Ciba-Geigy Corporation submitted a report amendment entitled,

Supplement to Combined Chronic Toxicity/Oncogenicity Study in Rats; J.R. Hazelette and J.D. Green; Project No. 842119; Study Completed on August 24, 1987; MRID No. 411842-01.

The "Records:" Section was amended to read as follows:

"The following minimum records, specimens, and a copy of the final report were maintained and stored in the Archives of Toxicology/Pathology that are located at the SEF in Summit, NJ.:"

As mentioned in a previous memorandum (John Whalan; EPA No. 80801-04; November 28, 1989), Ametryn was recently selected to be a pilot chemical in the FIFRA 88 review process. The Chronic Feeding/Oncogenicity Study in Rats was screened for acceptability for review at that time. The study was found to be unacceptable by HED Acceptance Criteria. This amended report does not alter the status of the study.
