The Agency has reviewed the waiver request for a solubility profile to upgrade the Invertebrate Toxicity Study with <u>Daphnia</u>, MRID 145757, guideline 72-2(a), for the chemical benfluralin (Chemical Number 84301, Case 2030) and has reached the following decision.

The Agency grants the waiver request provided that your submission of an Invertebrate Toxicity Study with <u>Daphnia</u>, MRID 42390702, guideline 72-2(b), which utilized the TEP as the test substance is acceptable.

This study, if acceptable, can be used to satisfy both the 72-2(a) and 72-2(b) guideline requirements.
