During the 1986 growing season, Monsanto sampled surface waters for alachlor in 30 Community Water Systems (CWS). The attached charts were taken from the final 1986 Monsanto study entitled, "Alachor, Atrazine, Cyanazine, Metolachlor, and Simazine in Surface Water from 30 CWS Located in Regions of Lasso Use," dated July 20, 1987, Accession #402659-01.

The highlighted areas show the location of the nine CWS with an Annualized Mean Concentration (AMC) above 0.5 micrograms/L (PPB) and the approximate population served. Monsanto reported that a total of approximately 603,500 people are served by the CWS having alachlor concentrations above 0.5 ppb. Lasso use category (level of use), and approximate water shed size (sq mi) are also given.
