The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection reported a fish kill caused by Nemacur (Fenamiphos) used on golf course. Evidentally, 5 inches of rain fell shortly after application resulting in massive fish die-offs in several lakes receiving runoff from the golf course. Concentrations in lakes ranged from 0-140 ppb.
