The registrant, Dow Corning, has requested the addition of new uses for the 72 percent concentrate of DC 5700. The uses are the treatment of premoistened towellelettes and tissue wipes.

Comments and Recommendations

1. The end-use dilutions of ai of the highly concentrated DC 5772 are the same as the original DC 5700 (42 percent ai).
2. Only the amount of methanol in the DC 5772 use dilution will differ from the of the DC 5700. (An insignificant point, toxicologically).
3. The label appears adequate for the requested use.
4. No further toxicity ^{data} is required for the requested uses.
