## Requested Action:

The registrant, Dow Corning, has requested the addition of new uses for the 72 percent concentrate of DC 5700. The uses are the treatment of premoistened towellettes and tissue wipes.

### Comments and Recommendations

- The end-use dilutions of ai of the highly concentrated DC 5772 are the same as the original DC 5700 (42 percent ai).
- Only the amount of methanol in the DC 5772 use dilution will differ from the of the DC 5700. (An insignificant point, toxicologically).
- 3. The label appears adequate for the requested use.
- 4. No further toxicity is required for the requested uses.
