1. The protocol for the teratogenicity study appears to be adequate, with respect to number of animals, dose levels, and parameters studied. A final rationale for the choice of dose level will be required, the highest dose should if possible show some minimal effects on either mothers or &etuses.

2. The male dominant lethal mutagenicity study is not acceptable primarily because of its lack of sensitivity. The registrant must be referred to the Guidelines. The Ames test as a non-mammalian test is acceptable,; to fulfull the requirements for the test in a mammaliaan system the in vivo cytogenetics (bone marrow) and the mouse heritable xx trans location test are acceptable.
