We have reviewed this supplemental report and previous reports submitted December 12, 1983, and January 18, 1984. We appreciate the careful, thorough observation/reporting and agree that conduct of the study to date has not defined adverse effects in non-target organism populations. We feel that completion of this study as originally planned, however, will be an ^{important} addition to the total data base for thiobencarb. The following items should be reported for this season of the study; analyses or sampling previously conducted but not cited below need not be included in the 1984 program:

- a. Initiate water and sediment sampling for thiobencarb residues immediately after application of Bolero to any of the fields that drain into the test bayou.
- b. Continue sampling for residues in fish.
- c. Continue sweep net sampling for invertebrates.

In addition, please indicate which fields will be treated and how many acres will be involved in this year's study. We would appreciate getting this information as soon as it is available.
