

1.0 INTRODUCTION

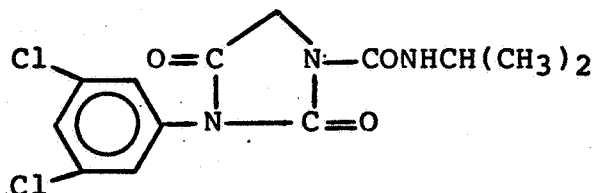
The Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services has submitted a Section 18 Emergency Exemption requesting authorization to use Rovral 50W (EPA Reg. No. 359-685, Iprodione as a. i.) for control of Sclerotinia blight of peanuts.

1.1 Chemical

Common name: Iprodione

Chemical name: 3-(3,5-dichlorophenyl)-N-(1-methylethyl)-2,4-dioxo-1-imidazolidine

2.0 DIRECTIONS FOR USE

The maximum cumulative dosage of Rovral 50W, resulting from multiple applications beginning with the onset of disease and ending at least 30 days prior to harvest, would not exceed 6 lb of product (3.0 lb ai/A. Application will be by ground spray application.

A maximum of 60,000 acres of peanuts in Virginia is expected to require chemical treatment. However, Rovral 50W will compete with other fungicides if approved under separate Section 18 requests.

The period of treatment will be from July 1 to September 30.

3.0 DISCUSSION OF DATA


No additional environmental fate data were included in the submission.

EAB files indicate that no rotational crop study had been submitted for Iprodione.

With the exception of rotational crop data, all other environmental fate data requirements have been satisfied.

4.0 RECOMMENDATION

EAB has no objection to the issuance of the emergency exemption for use of Iprodione for control of Sclerotinia blight on peanuts provided a rotational crop restriction is issued prohibiting planting crops other than peanuts in treated fields earlier than 12 months after last application.
