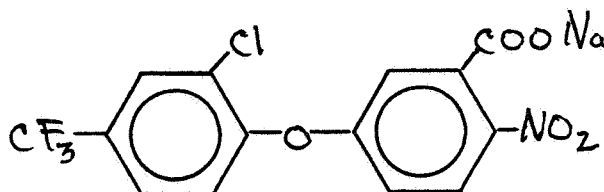

The registrant is applying for an ammended pesticide product registration to add rice to the labels of BLAZER 2S and BLAZER 2L. These herbicides are now registered for use on soybeans.

3.1 AEROBIC AQUATIC METABOLISM

- 3.1.1 Aerobic Aquatic Metabolism of ^{14}C -labeled RH-6201 (BLAZER), T.D. Rogerson, Spring House Res. Lab., Technical Report No. 36H-81-6, Section J, Tab 2 Acc # 070115.

Experimental Procedure

Two different radiolabeled versions of RH-6201 (^{14}C -labeled in the trifluoromethyl group, CF_3 ; and uiformly in the nitrophenyl ring, NPR) were added to 1000 ml quantities of water obtained from a typical rice paddy in Mississippi at concentrations of 1.0 ppm and 0.1 ppm. Both the concentration and identity of radiolabeled material were monitored using radioassay and/or TLC/radioautography. Sampling was on days 7, 14, 21, and 30 days.

BLAZER is stable in an aerobic aquatic environment and would dissipate fairly rapidly in water.

"Do not use treated water to irrigate other crops"
