The Ecological Effects Branch (EEB) has reviewed the request by Merck & Co. for a waiver on a Wild Mammal Field Study for abamectin use. Previously, EEB required that AGRI-MEK perform the mammal field study in order to evaluate impact of abamectin use on strawberries, lettuce, tomatoes and celery crops. According to a new policy, EEB will not require field studies, unless there are special conditions. Therefore, the EEB agrees to the requested waiver. However, the registrant should be aware that all risk assessments conducted on their chemical will be based on existing ecotoxicity and fate data (Rexrode 305-5578).
