Note to Chris Dively:

This is to inform you of two typographical errors that were found in EAB's PCO Exposure Assessment for cyfluthrin (Baythroid) dated March 16, 1987. The first paragraph in Section 5.0 on page 9 of the report should read:

"Based on data from surrogate studies and on usage data from BUD, the dermal exposure of PCOs wearing protective gloves is estimated to range from 100 to 760 ug/kg/lb ai handled. For applicators not wearing protective gloves, dermal exposure estimates range from 290 to 760 ug/kg/lb ai handled. Respiratory exposure is approximately 0.5 ug/kg/day for PCOs".
