On October 31, 1986, Rohm and Haas submitted petitions for temporary tolerances for processed commodities of apples and grapes, meat, milk, amd eggs. The issuance of these tolerances would allow removal of a fresh market restriction from the EUP labels and permit processing of damaged apples and grapes. Rohm and Haas has requested an expedited review to avoid "substantial renumeration costs for damaged crop".

Rohm and Haas has submitted revised Sections B and F as requested by the Residue Chemistry Branch. The petitioner has also presented some factors which they feel will mitigate dietary exposure.

I request that these reviews proceed as expeditiously as possible so that a temporary tolerance decision can be made, and if favorable, allow removal of the fresh market restriction from EUP labeling in time to be of use this season. We would like the Residue Chemistry and Toxicology Branch reviews completed by August 21, 1987.

The revised sections B and F have been routed to HED though normal channels.
