Attached are the Product and Residue Chemistry Chapters for DPX-V9360 (nicosulfuron, ACCENT™). The due date for these chapters is April 15, 1990.

This is a first time food-use permanent tolerance request for DPX-V9360. The review of the product chemistry and residue data has been done in a registration standard format.

As requested by the Registration Standards Policy Group, the product chemistry data for end-use products are not included in this Standard. This "generic" Standard is concerned with data which is relevant to the technical products of DPX-V9360 (nicosulfuron). Also, as requested by H. Harrison (RD), DEB no longer addresses the physical/chemical properties of manufacturing-use products. These will be considered by RD.

The Product Chemistry Chapter contains an appendix with Confidential Business Information (CBI) and is to be protected. All copies of the Standard contain such information.

The Dietary Risk Evaluation System (DRES) calculations are not yet available since this petition is a first-time request for a food tolerance for DPX-V9360. DEB recently (1/25/90) recommended favorably for Section 18 exemptions for corn forage, silage, fodder, and grain for the same proposed postemergence use on field corn.

Finally, DEB has completed the data tables for the Product Chemistry and Residue Chemistry Chapters and these are included in this package. If you need additional input, please advise.
