As per the memo dated 13 July 1994, EEB concurs with Rohm and Haas's request to add the 75 foot set-back to their label for ground and aerial applications to reduce aquatic exposure. EEB has also asked for additional mitigation measures to be identified to further reduce the chance of Fenbuconazole from entering aquatic systems.
