FMC has submitted a petition for time-limited tolerances for the combined residues of the herbicide sulfentrazone and its major metabolite 3-hydroxymethyl sulfentrazone on soybeans and rotational crops.

The current amendment consists of labels for Authority 4F and 75DF Herbicide. CBTS has previously reviewed these labels and found them to be acceptable (Memo, G. Kramer 7/31/96). Refer to the latter review for our recommendations on time-limited and permanent tolerances.
