This is a naturally occurring strain of *B. subtilis* being submitted for registration. The Subdivision M Guidelines for microbial pest controlled agents is arranged in a Tier scheme. As such, environmental expression testing is invoked only if an acute hazard has been shown in Tier I ecological effects testing. Therefore, there are no environmental expression testing requirements at this time.

This new chemical has passed the environmental fate portion of the screening process.
