## **Summary of Findings**

There is no mention of the CRP use directions used in the Senior Adult Use Effectiveness (SAUE) testing for the package in this labeling submission. The other products in this submission have a discrepancy between the CRP use directions used in SAUE testing and the CRP use directions on the box, package insert, package label, etc. in the retail market. Based on the aforementioned discrepancy the registrant must submit evidence that the CRP use directions used in SAUE testing are the CRP use directions on the retail package. Should this not be true, the registrant's CRP certification is no longer considered valid and they must retest the package with the CRP use directions that are on the retail package or change the CRP use directions on the retail package back to the directions used in SAUE testing.
