Subject: Harris Famous Roach Tablets

Your Letter Dated January 29, 1990

You have now satisfied all the requirements of the 1985 Boric Acid Registration Standard.

1. Each new tablet will have a total weight of 1250 milligrams and will contain 500 milligrams of boric acid. Product labeling can direct users to apply no more than three tablets per room.
2. The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the following comments.

a. Revise your ingredient statement as follows:

Active Ingredient:	
Boric Acid	40%
Inert Ingredients:	60%
<u>TOTAL</u>	<u>100%</u>

b. Modify referral statement to read:

See side panel for additional precautions.

c. Place all use directions on back panel.

d. Change "Manufactures" to "Manufactured".

e. Modify the beginning of your use directions as follows:

To control cockroaches, ants, and silverfish,
place no more than three tablets per room, in
sites ... wells.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.



dressers and chests of drawers, then place tablets
in drawer wells.

Any tablets visible after application must be pressed
into cracks and crevices or removed. Reapply as
necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store only in original container, in a
dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: DO NOT reuse empty container. Securely
wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.
