PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS - CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid contamination of feed, food-stuffs, fish ponds and water supplies. Do not use on pets, humans, meat animals, dairy cows, dairy barns, milk sheds, or forage crops to be fed meat or dairy animals. Remove or cover food, utensils (milking or eating), fish bowls and bird cages.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
- If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
- If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention immediately.

Avoid contamination of fish ponds and water supplies.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

BONIDE BUG FOG insecticide is formulated to kill flies, mosquitoes, punkies, gnats, fleas, ants, ticks, clothes moths and carpet beetles. May be used in sprayers or foggers to simplify control of above insects. Follow directions as listed for each pest. When applied at $\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 gallon per 1,000 sq. ft. area will give long lasting residual killing action. In all cases, however, repeat treatment when deemed necessary.

AS A SPRAY (Coarse, Wet):

For Flies, Mosquitoes, Punkies, Gnats - Apply thoroughly to screens, wall, ceiling, door and window frames or other areas that fly "specks" indicate as habitual resting places. Some mosquitoes prefer dark places - treat these also.

For Bedbugs - Apply thoroughly to springs, bed frames, cracks, crevices, wetting the surfaces. Also spray mattress, pay particular attention to seams and folds.

For Roaches, Water Bugs, Ticks, Silver Fish - Apply thoroughly in areas infested, cracks, crevices, dark or damp places, behind pipes, underneath sinks, etc., hit at as many insects as possible.

For Fleas - Spray rugs lightly but thoroughly. Do not use on rubber or foam backed rugs, such as indoor-outdoor types. Apply thoroughly to floors and other infested areas.

For Ants - Apply to hit as many insects as possible, spray runways and areas frequented.

Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles - Apply light spray mist, cover completely all articles to be protected. Pay particular attention to seams and folds. Apply thoroughly to inside of storage containers, on floor, baseboards, walls of closet. Spray rugs lightly, but thoroughly. Do not use on rubber or foam backed rugs, such as indoor-outdoor types. Repeat application 30 days.

A thorough spraying of manure piles, nearby walls and resting places in stables not used for dairy, meat animals or poultry will kill numerous stable flies before they leave their breeding ground.

AS A FOG:

For outside use around backyards, lawn areas, patios, swimming, sitting or eating areas to kill flying insects such as flies, mosquitoes, and gnats: Pour BUG FOG into fogging equipment and blanket area to be treated with thick dry fog prior to occupation of these areas. Do not treat vegetation or lawn directly, let fog drift onto these areas to deposit killing power.
