DIRECTIONS

For proper mixing, the spray tank should be at least ¾ filled with water before Malathion 50% E is added. Shake sprayer occasionally or agitate to keep spray particles in suspension during application. Follow spray schedule given in spray chart below.

ROSES, CHRYSANTHEMUMS, CARNATIONS (FLOWERS): For aphids, whiteflies, mealybugs, thrips and two-spotted mites. Spray as for ornamentals using ½ teaspoon/quart or 2 teaspoons per gallon of water.

ORNAMENTALS: Aphids, mealybugs, spider mites, whiteflies, four lined plant bugs, Japanese beetle, potato leafhopper, tarnished plant bugs, thrips, rose leafhopper, European pine shoot moth, birch leafminer, boxwood leafminer, bagworms, tent caterpillar.

Spray thoroughly both top and under-
 sides of leaves until slightly dripping
 as soon as insects appear. Repeat as
 needed. Injury may occur on ferns,
 hickory, viburnum, lantana, crassula
 and canaert juniper. Use ½ teaspoon/
 quart or 2 teaspoons per gallon water.

Oak kermes, azalea, pine leaf, mag-
 nolia, Fletcher, Florida red juniper,
 black, scurfy, euonymus, oyster shell,
 monterey pine, soft and pine needle
 scale insects. Apply as above using 1
 teaspoon/quart or 4 teaspoons/gallon
 of water.

ORNAMENTAL GREENHOUSE: (in and
 around greenhouses and flower gar-
 dens) millipedes, springtails, sow bugs.
 Apply when insects appear. Repeat at
 7-10 day intervals as needed. Use 1
 teaspoon/gallon water to 150 sq. ft.
 of soil surface.
