EPA Registration No. 4-99  
Your Amended Labeling Submitted December 16, 1987

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling incorporating the following corrections before you release the product for shipment.

1. Delete the claim for use on houseplants. This is an additional use which does not appear on your labeling previously accepted for the subject product. In addition, there are no directions on the label for use on houseplants.

If you wish to pursue the additional use on houseplants, you must:

- a. Comply with the data compensation procedures under 40 CFR 152 Subpart Z--Procedures to Ensure Protection of Data Submitters' Rights, and
  - b. Provide your proposed labeling for Directions for Use on houseplants.
2. The front panel claims for "fruit" and "vegetables" are misleading in that they imply that the product may be used on a wide variety of fruits and vegetables whereas the use directions on the subject amended labeling list a very limited number of these crops. Therefore, either list the fruits and vegetables on the front panel or qualify these claims by referencing the specific crops listed elsewhere, i.e., "the listed fruits and vegetables."

3. Replace the phrase "Spray as for cherries . . ." in the "When to Apply" column under peaches and pears with the directions under apricots on the current label since cherries are not included on the proposed label. Retain the respective 7- and 1-day preharvest intervals.
4. On the basis of percentage concentration in the spray mixture, 1.3 mL in 500 mL of water is equivalent to 2 teaspoons of product in a gallon of water and roughly equivalent to 2 pints per 100 gallons of water. In the following instances, the rates on the proposed labeling are not equivalent to those on the current label and must be revised accordingly: Beans, tomatoes, and corn. Refer to the enclosed copy of the efficacy review of the amended labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

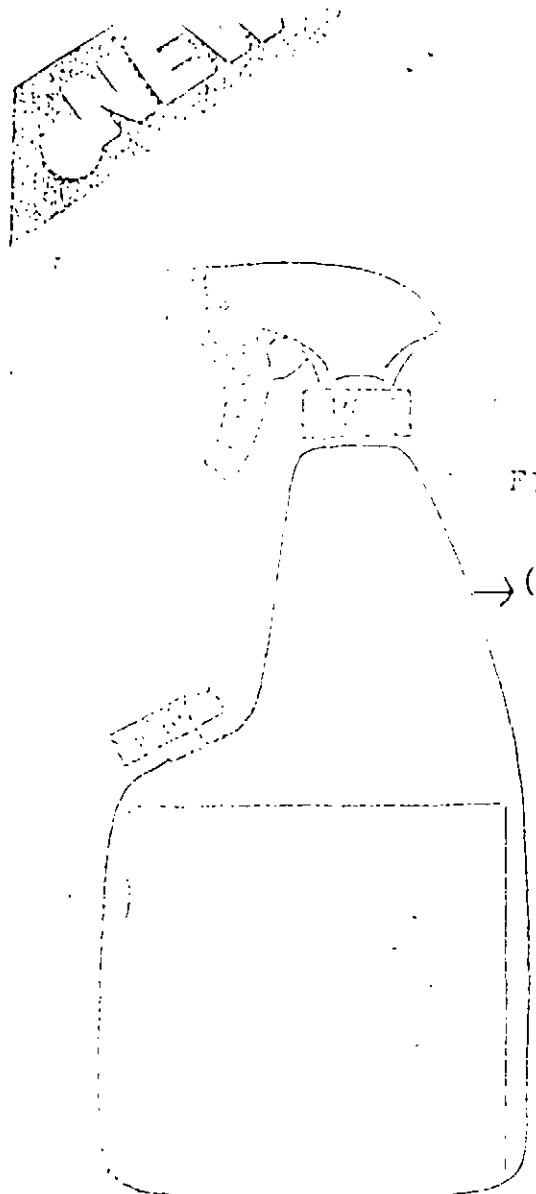

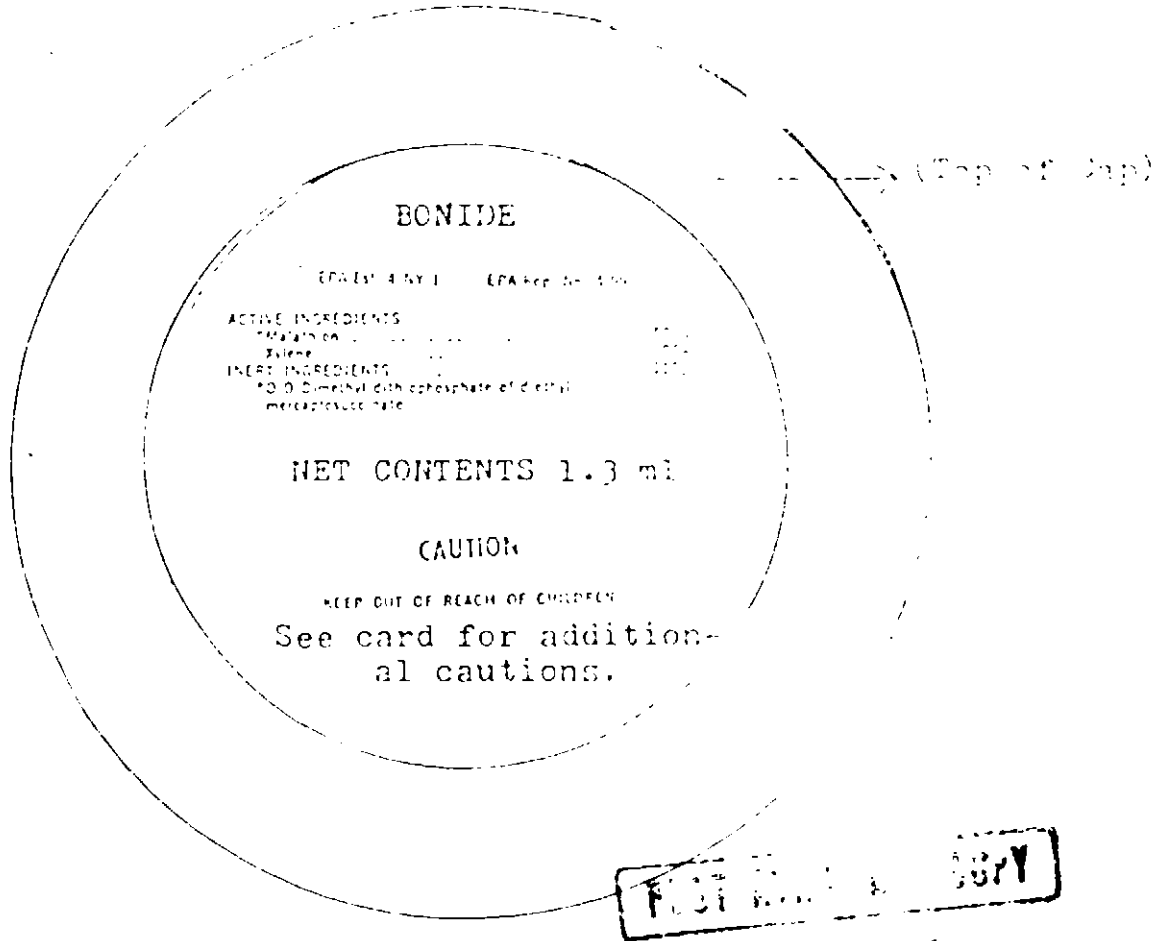
