


**WEED & BRUSH KILLER** containing Dupont Ammate<sup>®</sup> is highly effective for killing undesirable woody plant growth (i.e. poison ivy, poison oak, poison sumac, tree sprouts, brambles) and as a contact spray to kill weeds and grasses in driveways and walks. It may also be used to prevent sprouting of tree stumps and to kill undesirable trees.

**WEED & BRUSH KILLER** with Ammate<sup>®</sup> is water soluble, non-flammable, non-volatile (no fumes that could injure near-by plants) and non-selective (will kill desirable plants if applied to them). Heavy applications causing temporary soil non-productivity can give reasonable extended periods of control; this condition usually disappears over winter. Some species of woody plants and perennial weeds difficult to control may need re-treatment if regrowth occurs.

**WEED & BRUSH KILLER** with Ammate<sup>®</sup> is easily applied by tank sprayer, sprinkling jar or can.

**DIRECTIONS**

Choosing a calm period will avoid damage to near-by growth, possibly valuable, from wind-carried spray drift. Coarse sprays (large droplets or stream) are less likely to drift. Direct sprays away from lawns or desirable plants to avoid injury.

**CAUTION:** Avoid contact of skin with solution or spray. In case of contact and after use wash thoroughly with water. Store out of reach of children.

**IMPORTANT:** Rinse sprayer, hose and nozzle or sprinkling can thoroughly after use to remove traces of product and reduce corrosion. Do not drain or flush equipment or mixing utensils on desirable plants or vegetation. "Ammate" absorbs moisture readily, keep package tightly closed after use. If hardened in the package drop or slap bag on flat hard surface — particles will break loose.

**For control of woody plants**, such as poison ivy, poison oak, poison sumac, tree sprouts, brambles, and other brush, use 1 lb. to 9½ pints (approx. 1.2 gallon) of water. Apply as a drenching spray anytime after foliage is well developed until foliage begins to discolor due to frost. Wet foliage thoroughly. For best results, spray during periods of high humidity. For foliage difficult to wet, add ¼ teaspoonful of Du Pont Spreader-Sticker or one tablespoonful of household detergent per gallon. Respray if any recovery is noted. For woody plants under apple & pear trees — do not allow spray or drift to contact tree foliage or fruit as injury will result. If on tree trunks spray only if bark is well developed and shows no green. Avoid excessive wetting of bark. Use 1 cupful (0.6 lb.) per gallon water to 250 square feet or approximately 2 gallons of spray per tree of 25 foot spread.


**To kill vegetation** in driveways, walks, tennis courts and similar locations, use 1 lb. to 9½ pints (approx. 1.2 gallon) of water for 30 square feet. Apply uniformly to vegetation to be killed. The degree of control and duration of effect will vary with weed species, rainfall, temperature, and other conditions.

**To prevent sprouting of tree stumps**, apply dry "Ammate" liberally on freshly cut stump surface especially around the outer edge, or spray surface thoroughly with solution of 4 lbs. to 9½ pints (approx. 1.2 gallon) of water.

**To kill undesirable trees**, make a continuous cut or "frill" around the base of the tree with downward axe strokes, cutting into the sapwood. Apply dry "Ammate" as a continuous band in the frill, or saturate frill with solution of 4 lbs. to 9½ pints (approx. 1.2 gallon) of water.
