The revised labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, is acceptable. Submit one copy of final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

We approve your plan to sticker over the "Statement of Practical Treatment" on your existing inventory before you release any product for shipment. You should have been informed by the Zinc Phosphide Consortium that you are no longer required to sticker over labels already in channels of trade. Instead, we have agreed that registrants should issue an informational bulletin to their distributors. distributors must issue the bulletin to all retailers to be provided with all product not yet sold. You must submit to the Agency a copy of the bulletin and a list of your distributors.

This registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e) if you do not comply with these conditions. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
