PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. May be absorbed through the skin. Avoid contamination of food and feed. Avoid inhalation of dust. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. In case of contact and after use, wash thoroughly with soap and water.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Store in a cool, dry place, and in an area inaccessible to children or pets.  
Wrap container in newspaper and place in trash collection.

The small containers of this product are self contained dusters. By squeezing the sides with rapid motion, a dusting action not unlike mechanical dusters can be achieved. Light applications meaning a thin film of dust are sufficient. Do not apply where children are likely to come in frequent contact with treated areas. Do not contaminate food, food containers or cooking utensils. Repeat applications as necessary.

**Ants and Silverfish (Indoors):** Dust thoroughly areas around water pipes, in cracks, under and behind cabinets, refrigerators, and sinks, and around doors, windows and book cases.

**Carpet Beetles:** Dust along baseboards, under carpeting, rugs, furniture wherever these insects are seen or suspected.

**Resistant and Non-resistant Cockroaches (Waterbugs):** Dust thoroughly all areas where roaches crawl and hide, such as around water pipes, in cracks and crevices, under and behind cabinets, refrigerators and sinks.

**Spiders and Scorpions (Indoors and Outdoors) —** Dust around windows, doors and along baseboards. Make spot applications to surfaces over which these pests crawl, particularly in crawl spaces under houses and buildings.

**Outdoors:** To control ants and clover mites, treat a 5 foot band of soil around the house as well as the house foundation wall to height of 2-3 feet. Repeat application if necessary.

**Box Elder Bugs:** Apply dust to insects; at the same time thoroughly treat around foundation, windows, doors, tree trunks, cracks and other places where the insects hide.

**Ants and Digger Wasps:** Spot treat thoroughly ant hills (day and night), and wasp ground nest openings at night. Cover openings after treatment.

Your Application dated April 2, 1984

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Revise the ACTIVE INGREDIENT (note singular) declaration to read: DIAZINON[0,0-Diethyl 0-(2-isopropyl-6-methyl-4-pyrimidinyl) phosphorothioate]. Note addition of name, brackets and reverse order of 6 and 4.
2. Revise "Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds" to "Do not apply directly to water."
3. Please refer to the enclosed type size guide for assistance in selecting the correct print size for the front panel signal word, child hazard warning, and the heading "Storage and Disposal."

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

S. A Statement of Practical Treatment must be added to the labeling. We suggest the following statement, however, if your toxicological data suggests otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for prior approval:

- If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.
- If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
