



### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS — CAUTION

This spray is not recommended for use on plants.


### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

### DIRECTIONS

To spray, remove protective cap from top of can. Hold dispenser upright and aim spray opening away from you. Press button to release mist. Keep dispenser at least three feet from any surface during application.

#### FOR FLEAS (Dog and Cat)

Spray thoroughly sleeping quarters of animals, cellar or such places where pests occur in the home. (Do not apply to animal.) Repeat treatment when necessary.

#### FOR BED BUGS, ROACHES, ANTS

Spray the material thoroughly with force into all parts of the room, paying special attention to cracks and crevices and hitting as many of the insects as possible. For controlling bed bugs, take beds, dressers, etc., apart and spray thoroughly all surfaces and cracks of every piece. Pay particular attention to springs, slats and mattress and all places in the room where the bugs may hide should be thoroughly sprayed.

Watch infested room closely and repeat treatment as often as necessary.

#### FOR FLIES AND MOSQUITOES

Close doors and windows and thoroughly spray material in all parts of the room, particularly toward the ceiling, filling the room with a fine mist. Keep the room closed for about fifteen minutes, and the fallen insects can then be swept up and destroyed. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

#### FOR MOTHS, CARPET BEETLE, SILVERFISH

Brush and clean clothing or rugs. Spray clothing thoroughly, making sure to reach seams, folds and other hiding places. Spray rugs lightly but thoroughly. Do not use on rubber or foam backed rugs, such as indoor-outdoor types. Spray thoroughly closets, trunks and other storage places making sure to reach all hiding places. Repeat every three or four weeks.
