**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

- if swallowed - Drink 24 or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.
- if inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration as indicated.
- if on skin - Wash promptly with copious water. Rinse thoroughly.
- if in eyes - Flush eyes for 15 minutes with water. Remove contact lenses if present.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

**HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS - CAUTION**  
May be fatal if swallowed. Contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid breathing spray mist. In case of contact with skin, wash with soap and water. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD**

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product may not be used against any pests not named on the label.

This product may be applied under the direct supervision of a certified applicator who is not physically present at the site of application, but is, nonetheless, available to the person applying the pesticide.

For use in accordance with the recommendations and instructions issued by USDA for quarantine programs. To be used only by or under the supervision of Federal/State quarantine personnel for quarantine treatments for nursery stock. Use on turf is prohibited. Restricted to use on land growing nursery stock and nursery stock itself.

For black vine weevil control, treat the plants, especially the branches closest to the ground, drench the ground and work into the top 4 inches of soil. Use sufficient water, approximately 500 gallons/acre for thorough coverage.

RESTRICTIONS: 1) For compliance with State Nursery Certification Regulations, 2) Use on turf is prohibited, 3) Restricted to use on land growing nursery stock or nursery stock itself.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

1. Prohibitions - Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. 2. Pesticide Disposal - Pesticide, spray, mixture, or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. 3. Container Disposal - Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in approved landfill or bury in a safe place. 4. General - Consult federal, state, or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.
