The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA Sec. ~~3(c)(7)(A)~~, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA Sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before your release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. Add the following as the first sentence of the "If swallowed" STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

"Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately."

b. Revise your "DISPOSAL" section as follows:

"STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection."

c. "Diazinon" is now the commonly accepted name for the active ingredient in this formulation. Either insert "Diazinon" immediately preceding the chemical name, or alternatively, you may insert "Diazinon" in place of the chemical name, footnoting the chemical name at the bottom of the ingredients statement.



3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
