


SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

DOGS AND CATS: Dilute at the rate of 3 ounces in 1 gallon of water. For rapid control of *Ticks*, *Fleas* and *Lice*, sponge or dip solution on entire animal, thoroughly wetting the skin. Avoid contact with pet's face, eyes and genitalia.

Do NOT treat kitten or puppies less than four weeks old.

FOR RAPID CONTROL OF TICKS, FLEAS AND LICE WITH A MIST SPRAY: Dilute at the rate of 1 ounce in 9 ounces of water. To insure thorough coverage, part the fur by stroking against the lay of the hair as spray is applied. Spray ticks directly. Apply to moisten the fur lightly.

TO CONTROL INSECTS IN KENNELS AND ANIMALS QUARTERS: Dilute at the rate of 2 ounces in 20 ounces of water. Remove pets before treating the area and ventilate thoroughly before allowing them to re-enter the treated area.

For rapid cleansout of *Fleas* and *Ticks* in kennels, apply with a good machine adjusted to deliver coarse droplets. Apply to the point of runoff, with special attention to cracks and crevices and other insect hiding places. Bedding should be removed and sprayed thoroughly. To prevent reoccurrence of fleas, a total management program is recommended. You should treat the areas where fleas live with the Aqueous Pyrenone 4-Step Program which consists of:

- Step 1 - Shampoo/Dip and pet
 - Step 2 - Treat the home and yard
 - Step 3 - Flea and Tick collars on the pet
 - Step 4 - Maintenance Sprays and powders
- Ask your pet care professional for specific recommendations on how to best control fleas for the comfort and well being of your pet and family.
