If possible, remove and destroy nest to prevent hatching of new insects. For ground nests, carefully dust entrance and surrounding areas. Retreat in one or two days if wasp activity is still present. Do not use this product to treat overhead nests.

Nuisance Pests Indoors

Application within residential buildings including homes and apartment buildings and within non-food areas of industrial, institutional and commercial buildings including hospitals, stores, manufacturing plants and warehouses.

For Control of Carpet Beetles: Apply dust as a spot treatment along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture, in closets and on shelving, and wherever else these insects are seen or suspected.

Fleas and Ticks on Premises: Dust thoroughly all infested areas, particularly crevices in woodwork, floor and floor covering, and animal sleeping quarters.

Bedbugs: Dismantle beds completely and dust all parts thoroughly, including, mattress seams and box springs. Dust all baseboards and wall cracks thoroughly.

Lice on Poultry: Dust the powder carefully into the feathers, under the wings, along the back and around the vent. Rub into feathers of the head. Nests, roosts, and runways, porches and cages should be thoroughly dusted. Destroy infested food and cuttlebone. Repeat no more than once per week as needed.

Lice on Pet Birds: Dust the powder carefully into the feathers, under the wings, along the back and around the vent. Rub into feathers of the head. Nests, roosts, and runways, porches and cages should be thoroughly dusted. Destroy infested food and cuttlebone. Repeat no more than once per week as needed.

DOGS AND CATS

Do not repeat treatment for seven (7) days. Do not use on puppies or kittens under twelve (12) weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant, nursing or medicated animals.
