2. Make the following label changes:
 - a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 4-383."
 - b. Under Environmental Hazards delete "For terrestrial uses." This incorrectly implies that your product has aquatic uses. See PR Notice 93-8 for more information.
 - c. Remove the statement "WARNING: Contains methyl chloroform, a substance which harms public health and environment by destroying ozone in the upper atmosphere." According to your product's CSF and the CSFs of the products used as sources of active ingredient for your product, it does not contain methyl chloroform. If your product does contain methyl chloroform, you must revise your CSF and report this information to the Agency.
 - d. Delete "Ornamental" from product name since there are no ornamentals nor directions for use on ornamentals.

TO CONTROL THE FOLLOWING INSECTS: Alfalfa Caterpillar, Alfalfa Looper, Aphid, Armyworm, Artichoke Plume Moth, Beet Armyworm, Buckthorn Aphid, Cabbage Looper, Carrot Weevil, Celery Looper, Chinch Bug, Colorado Potato Beetle, Corn Earworm, Corn Rootworm (adults), Cowpea Curculio, Cucumber Beetle (adults) - spotted and striped, Cutworm, Diamondback Moth, European Corn

Borer, Flea Beetle, Grasshopper, Green Cloverworm, Imported Cabbageworm, Leafhopper, Looper, Lygus Bug, Mexican Bean Beetle, Painted Lady Caterpillar, Pea Aphid, Pea Weevil, Pepper Weevil, Pickleworm, Potato Leafhopper, Potato Psyllid, Potato Tuberworm, Rindworm, Saltmarsh Caterpillar, Sap Beetle, Southwestern Corn Borer, Squash Bug, Squash Vine Borer, Stalk Borer, Stink Bug, Tarnished Plant Bug, Tobacco Hornworm, Tomato Fruitworm, Tomato Hornworm, Tomato Pinworm, Vegetable Leafminer, Velvetbean Caterpillar, Western Bean Cutworm, and Whitefly.

To control listed insects, apply the spray to provide thorough coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat treatment weekly or as needed throughout the growing season up to days of harvest given for each crop.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE:: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
