Use Restrictions:

INSECTS: Hot Pepper Wax Concentrate repels aphids, spider mites, thrips, leaf miners, whiteflies, lace bugs, leafhoppers and scale from fruits and vegetables including: citrus fruits, root and tuber vegetables, bulb vegetables, leafy vegetables, brassica (cole) leafy vegetables, legume vegetables, fruiting vegetables and cucurbit vegetables. It also can be used on all indoor and outdoor ornamental plants.

Apply Hot Pepper Wax Concentrate using spray equipment. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Mixing, Application, and Retreatment Directions for Plants: Apply Hot Pepper Wax Concentrate, as diluted below, as a foliar spray to the leaves, stems, fruits, and flowers of the plant until wet. Do not drench roots in soil or media. Do not apply when rain is expected within 24 hours.

IF TREATMENT AREA IS LESS THAN 1 ACRE: INITIAL rate is 1 part Hot Pepper Wax Concentrate to 16 parts WATER (8 oz. or 16 Tbs. per gallon of water). Apply until foliage is wet or a maximum of 3 gallons prepared solution per 1000 square feet. Repeat application in 3-7 days, for 2-3 weeks, until control is established. ONCE CONTROL IS ESTABLISHED use MAINTENANCE rate of 1 part Hot Pepper Wax Concentrate to 32 parts WATER (4 oz. or 8 Tbs. per gallon of water) every 2-4 weeks, as necessary to maintain control.

IF TREATMENT AREA IS 1 ACRE OR MORE: INITIAL rate is a maximum of 6 gallons Hot Pepper Wax Concentrate to a minimum 100 gallons WATER per acre. Apply until foliage is wet. Repeat application, if necessary, in 1 to 2 weeks, until control is established. ONCE CONTROL IS ESTABLISHED use MAINTENANCE rate of 2 gallons Hot Pepper Wax Concentrate to a minimum 100 gallons WATER per acre, every 2-4 weeks, as necessary to maintain control.

Hose-end Sprayer Instructions

HOW TO USE

Make sure water control knob on hose sprayer is in the "OFF" position. Hold by handle and shake vigorously, turning bottle as you shake. Attach hose to spray nozzle. Bend safety tab back and break off. Turn control to "WATER" position. Slowly turn on water supply to moderate rate of flow. Point nozzle toward spray area, turn control knob to "ON". Product will automatically mix with the water. Slowly sweep the area to be treated. To stop spraying, turn control valve to the "OFF" position. Turn off water at faucet. To relieve pressure, turn control valve to the "WATER" position pointing sprayer away from self. Remove from hose.
